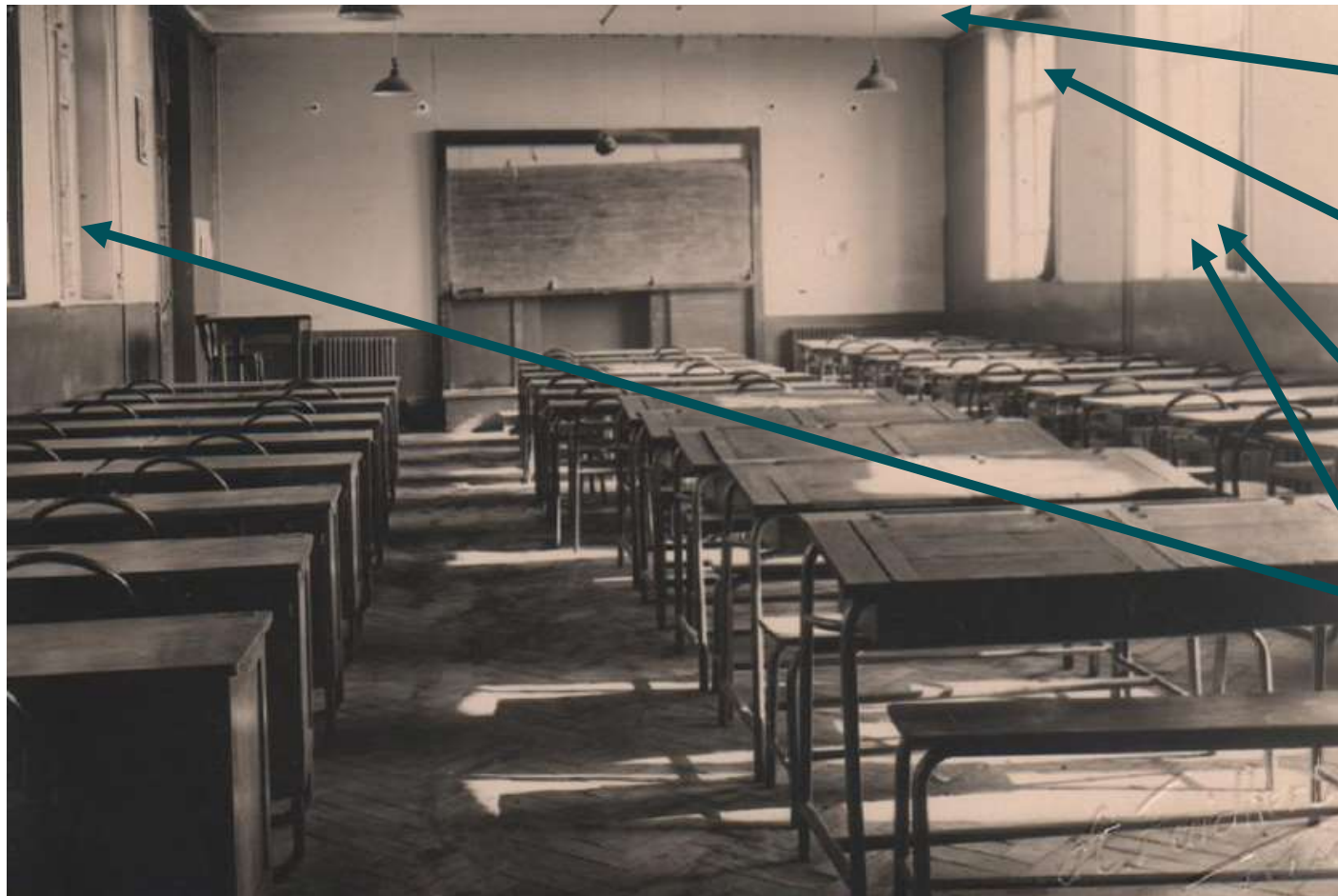




AIR AND LIGHT FOR CLASSROOMS SCHOOL BUILDINGS IN THE 19th CENTURY

- 1 HIGH CEILINGS TO INCREASE ROOM VOLUME
- 2 HIGH WINDOW FOR CONTINUOUS VENTILATION
- 3 LARGE WINDOW OPENS WIDE FOR BETTER VENTILATION
- 4 OPPOSING OPENINGS FOR THROUGH-AIR FLOW
- 5 ALL WINDOWS FACE DIRECTLY OUTSIDE (RATHER THAN INTO A CORRIDOR, FOR EXAMPLE) TO IMPROVE VENTILATION.
